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**CONSENT AGREEMENT**

I.

This agreement is hereby entered into between the State of Mississippi, Secretary of State's Office, Business Regulation and Enforcement Division (hereinafter "Division"), by and through James O. Nelson, II, Assistant Secretary of State, and THOMAS MORE LAW CENTER (hereinafter "Respondent"), by and through its agent.

The Division, having the power to administer and to provide for the enforcement of all provisions of the Mississippi Charitable Solicitations Act (hereinafter "Act"), and Respondent do hereby enter into this Consent Agreement in resolution of the following allegations by the Division of violations of certain provisions of the Act:

1. Respondent, a registered charitable organization, continued to solicit contributions in or from this state after the date such organization should have filed, but failed to file, a renewal and the financial report in accordance with the requirements of Sections 79-11-501 through 79-11-529 in violation of Miss. Code Ann. §79-11-503(6).

2. The Division records reveal that this is Respondent's second offense.

Respondent, under the terms of this Consent Agreement and solely for the purpose of resolving the foregoing allegations, stipulates without a hearing to the matters set forth above in Paragraph I and hereby consents to the issuance of this Consent Agreement and further consents to and agrees to the undertakings contained herein. Furthermore, the undersigned agent for the Respondent acknowledges that he has been lawfully vested with the authority to enter into this Consent Agreement on behalf of the Respondent.

### III.

THEREFORE, in consideration of a final resolution of the matters set forth above in Paragraph I and taking into account that this incident is Respondent's third offense in the State of Mississippi, the Division and Respondent hereby agree and stipulate to the following:

1. The Division shall impose a penalty upon the Respondent in the amount of one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) for violating the statutes aforementioned in Paragraph I. Respondent shall remit payment to the Division, payable to the "Mississippi Secretary of State" within fifteen (15) days of the execution of this agreement.

2. This Consent Agreement is in resolution of the matters contained in Paragraph I. Thus, any matters in Paragraph I will not be used as a basis for action by the Division except as set forth in Paragraph IV *infra*.


3. Respondent agrees to comply with the provisions of the Act in the future.

### IV.

In the event Respondent fails or neglects to comply with any of these agreements, stipulations or undertakings set forth in this Consent Agreement, the Division may,

without notice to Respondent, unilaterally rescind this Agreement and institute any legal or administrative proceedings it deems appropriate, but not limited to, proceedings to address the matters set forth in Paragraph I *supra*.
