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**ORDER LIFTING FINAL ORDER DENYING REGISTRATION**

The Securities and Charities Division of the Mississippi Secretary of State's Office ("Division"), by and through TANYA G. WEBBER, hereby issues this Order Lifting the Order Denying Registration of VISION AMERICA MOBILIZED, INC. ("Respondent"). In support thereof, the Division would show the following.

**I. JURISDICTION**

The Mississippi Charitable Solicitations Act, codified at Miss. Code Ann. §79-11-501, *et seq.* (2001) ("Act"), gives the Secretary of State the authority to, *inter alia*, regulate "charitable organizations" that solicit donations in the State of Mississippi. The Secretary of State has jurisdiction over this matter and the persons herein.

**II. FACTS AND LAW**

1. The Secretary of State issued a Final Order Denying Registration and Imposing Administrative Penalty on June 1, 2006. Such Order was mailed to the Respondent's attorney via certified mail, return receipt requested, on June 5, 2006.

2. The Secretary of State issued the June 1, 2006, order based on Respondent's failure to properly maintain books and records as provided in Section 79-11-518 of the Mississippi Charitable Solicitations Act.
3. On July 9, 2012, Respondent filed an initial registration application.
4. On August 21, 2012, the Secretary of State issued a Consent Agreement demanding payment of the outstanding penalty imposed in the June 1, 2006, Order and agreed to lift that Order upon payment of the penalty and return of a signed copy of the Consent Agreement.
5. Respondent returned a signed copy of the August 21, 2012, Consent Agreement and paid the administrative penalty in the amount of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) on September 10, 2012.

### III. PUBLIC INTEREST


The actions taken and proposed to be taken herein by the Secretary of State are in the public interest and are consistent with the purposes set out in Miss. Code Ann. § 79-11-501, *et seq.*

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED**, pursuant to the authority set out in the Act, that the Final Order Denying Registration and Imposing Administrative Penalty issued on June 1, 2006, is hereby lifted as to the provisions denying registration.


