

Petition Instructions

- Petitions must be printed on legal size paper.
- The petition form must be on one side and the initiative language must be printed on the other side or on a separate legal sized sheet of paper attached to each sheet of the petition.
- Petitions must be returned to THE SPONSOR and not directly to the Secretary of State's office.
- All signatures must be those of registered voters in Mississippi and must be signed personally by that voter. No voter can sign on behalf of another voter.
- The circulator must fill out the section at the bottom of the petition.
- The entire petition must be submitted to the Secretary of State at one time by THE SPONSOR.
- Signatures must be verified by the appropriate circuit clerk before being submitted to the Secretary of State.
