Tuesday, May 25, 2010.....Pre- Election Report
(January 1, 2010, through May 22, 2010) All Primary Candidates

Tuesday, June 15, 2010.....Pre-Runoff Report
(May 23, 2010, through June 12, 2010) Runoff Candidates Only

Tuesday, October 26, 2010.....Pre-General Report
(May 23, 2010, through October 23, 2010) All Candidates

Tuesday November 16, 2010.....Pre-Runoff Report
(October 24, 2010 through November 13, 2010) Runoff Candidates

Monday, January 31, 2011.....Annual Report
(January 1, 2010, through December 31, 2010) All candidates and all political committees that made expenditures in Mississippi during the 2010 period
