

B. New Fields was the subject of an examination by the Division, commencing July 24, 2013. During the course of that examination, the following determinations were made:

1. New Fields were not maintaining adequate books and records of all of its solicitation activities. New Fields failed to submit all of the requested exam documents. As a result, New Fields violated Section 79-11-518 of the Act and Rule 2.13 of the Mississippi Charities Act Rules.

2. New Fields failed to notify the Division of changes in its registration materials within thirty (30) days as required by law. As a result, New Fields violated Section 79-11-503(5).

3. The Division determined that New Fields failed to use all of the contributions it received for its stated charitable purpose in violation of Section 79-11-509(1)(d) as transfers were made with charity funds that didn't have the supporting documentation or explanations to justify the purchases.

III. STIPULATIONS

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby agreed as follows:

C. Respondent admits to the jurisdiction of the Division as to all matters herein.

D. Respondent neither admits nor denies that its conduct was in violation of the Act.

E. Respondent consents to the payment of One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) to be paid upon the execution of this Consent Agreement. Payment shall be remitted to the "Mississippi Secretary of State" upon execution of this Agreement.

F. Respondent agrees to cease operating as a charity in the State of Mississippi.

G. Respondent agrees to submit the Final Report in preparation of ceasing all solicitation activities in the State of Mississippi. The Final Report should be submitted upon execution of this Consent Agreement.

H. A willful failure to comply with any of the terms, conditions or obligations of this Agreement will result in Respondent being deemed to be in violation of a lawful order made pursuant to the Act and, therefore, subject to the penalties available under the Act.

I. Respondent is aware of its right to a hearing on the matters set forth in the Agreement, at which it may be represented by counsel, present evidence and cross-examine witnesses. Respondent hereby irrevocably waives its right to such a hearing.

J. The entry of this Agreement represents the settlement of regulatory claims by the Division against Respondent only and does not, in any way, restrict or affect the rights or causes of action, if any, of any individual or entity.

K. Respondent acknowledges that it has read this Consent Agreement in its entirety and fully understands the rights, terms, and obligations contained therein.

IV. OTHER MATTERS

L. In the event that Respondent fails to comply with the provisions of this Agreement, the Division may, without notice to the Respondent, unilaterally rescind this Agreement and institute any legal or administrative proceedings it deems appropriate including, but not limited to, proceedings to address the matters set forth herein.

WHEREFORE, the undersigned hereby acknowledges and agrees to the terms and conditions of the foregoing Agreement by written consent.
