**ORDER LIFTING FINAL ORDER DENYING REGISTRATION
AND IMPOSING ADMINISTRATIVE PENALTY**

THE SECRETARY OF STATE OF MISSISSIPPI, by and through the undersigned representative, hereby issues this Order Lifting the Final Order Denying Registration and Imposing Administrative Penalty issued against PAN AMERICAN HEALTH AND EDUCATION FOUNDATION. In support thereof, the Secretary of State respectfully submits as following:

I. JURISDICTION

The Secretary of State is vested with the regulation of charitable organizations pursuant to Miss. Code Ann. Sections 79-11-501, *et seq.* (Rev. 2009) (the "Act"). Pan American Health & Education Foundation ("Pan American") is a charitable organization as defined by the Act and is, therefore, subject to the Secretary of State's regulatory authority. The Secretary of State has jurisdiction over this matter and the party herein.

II. FACTS AND LAW

1. The Business Regulation and Enforcement Division of the Mississippi Secretary of State's Office ("Division") issued a Notice of Intent to Deny Registration and Impose Administrative Penalty ("NOI") against Pan American on October 4, 2007 for failure to

submit a complete renewal registration after several requests.

2. Pan American did not respond to the NOI.
3. Therefore the Division issued a Final Order Denying Registration and Imposing Administrative Penalty against Pan American on November 9, 2007. Said order was mailed to Pan American via certified mail, return receipt requested. The Division received confirmation that the NOI was received by Pan American.
4. In November 2014, Pan American submitted a complete renewal registration package to the Division.
5. The Division and Pan American entered into a Consent Agreement that resolved all registration issues.
6. Therefore, the Final Order Denying Registration and Imposing Administrative Penalty issued on November 9, 2007 is hereby lifted.

III. PUBLIC INTEREST




