CONSENT ORDER

I.

The Securities and Charities Division of the Mississippi Secretary of State's Office ("Division"), having the authority to administer and to provide for the enforcement of all provisions of the Mississippi Charitable Solicitations Act ("Act"), and Respondent do hereby enter into this Consent Order in resolution of the following allegations by the Division of violations of certain provisions of the Act:

1. Youth Achievement League ("YAL") is a non-profit organization with the stated purpose to "To fund any organization of need that helps today's youth. Including, but not limited to, missing children, abused children, terminally ill children and mentally and physically handicapped".
2. YAL was registered with the Division through November 30, 2009, at which time its registration expired. YAL failed to renew its registration and has now indicated that it will not renew its registration or continue to solicit funds in the State of Mississippi.
3. On April 16, 2010, the Division issued a Summary Cease and Desist Order and Notice of Intent to Deny Registration and Impose Administrative Penalty against YAL for its failure to produce records, submitting an incomplete renewal registration, and for certain information contained in the registration.

II.

Respondent, under the terms of this Consent Order and solely for the purpose of resolving the foregoing allegations, stipulates without a hearing to the matters set forth above in Paragraph I and hereby consents to the issuance of this Consent Order and further consents to and agrees to the undertakings contained herein, with no formal administrative hearing and determination of wrongdoing.

III.

THEREFORE, in consideration of a final resolution of the matters set forth herein, the Division and Respondent hereby agree and stipulate as follows:

1. Respondent stipulates to the jurisdiction of the Division as to all matters contained herein under the authority of the Act and acknowledges that the issuance of this Consent Order is solely for the purpose of resolving the matters contained in this Consent Order.
2. Respondent agrees that it will cease soliciting contributions in the State of Mississippi. Respondent agrees that that if it decides to solicit contributions in the State of Mississippi in the future, it will complete registration prior to the solicitation.
3. Respondent agrees that it will terminate its registration with the Division and will submit a final report to the Division as required by Miss. Code Ann. § 79-11-503(8).
4. Respondent agrees to submit the final report to the Division by Friday, August 20, 2010.
5. This Consent Order is in resolution of the matters contained herein. As a result of this Consent Order, the matters contained herein cannot be used as a basis for action by the Division except in determining any penalty as may be imposed by the Division for any future violations of the Act committed by the Respondent and as set forth below.

6. Respondent agrees that it will comply with the provisions of the Mississippi Charitable Solicitations Act as currently in effect or as may be subsequently amended.

IV.

In the event Respondent fails or neglects to comply with any of the terms, stipulations or undertakings set forth in this Consent Order, the Division may, without notice to the Respondent, unilaterally rescind this Order and institute any legal or administrative proceedings it deems appropriate including, but not limited to, proceedings to address the matters set forth herein.


