

Promote the Vote is gearing up for its big event---the annual Mock Election. The official mock election dates are October 27-30; however, if you have conflicts with these dates, your school may participate *BEFORE* and still have your votes counted in the overall statewide total. The paper ballots, VOTER ID activity, elections guide and tally sheet are available on the website under Mock Election. You must be registered and logged in to be able to access these materials.

All vote totals must be submitted to the Secretary of State's Office by **no later than 5:00 p.m. on Thursday, October 30**. Announcement of the statewide results will be posted before the General Election on Tuesday, November 4. Results may be submitted via phone, fax, mail or email at the information listed below:
