EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 1334

WHEREAS, we are indebted to Sergeant Stauffer, who was a well-respected and professional law enforcement officer, for his service and commitment to the people of the city of Tupelo; and


WHEREAS, the prayers of this State are with Gale's wife, Beth, young children, Dixie and Skip, and his many other family members and friends:

NOW, THEREFORE, I Phil Bryant, by the authority vested in me as Governor by the Constitution and laws of the State of Mississippi, do hereby proclaim a day of official mourning in the State of Mississippi in memory of Sergeant Kevin Gale Stauffer, Jr., and do hereby order the State Flag on all buildings and grounds of the State of Mississippi and all areas under its jurisdiction fly at half-staff, beginning at sunrise and ending at sunset on Friday, December 27, 2013.
