Short explanation of rule/amendment/repeal and reason(s) for proposing rule/amendment/repeal: Due to the issues related to the COVID-19 emergency and the impact the spread of the disease has had on the meat supply chain, the Department issues this temporary rule EXTENSION in an effort to increase meat availability to consumers. The temporary rule will increase the number of people who can own an animal (cattle, sheep, swine, and goats) from four to multiple owners for the purposes of the custom slaughter exemption of the meat inspection laws. This is a 90-day renewal of effectiveness. Original system number: 24883

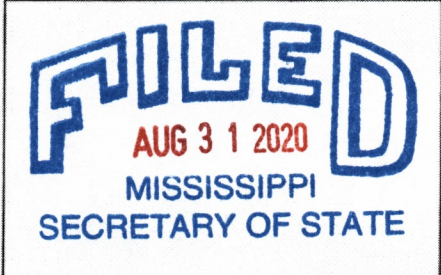
