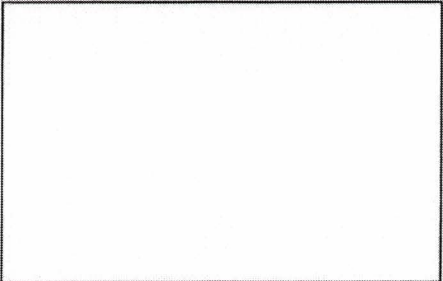
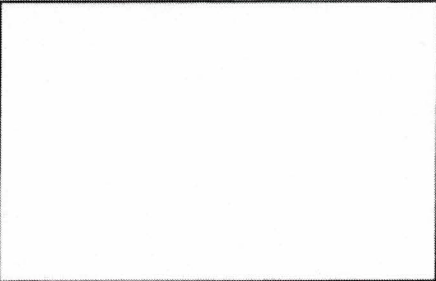

105 Emergency Rule to Authorize the Mississippi Agricultural and Livestock Theft Bureau to
Provide Law Enforcement Assistance on State Fairgrounds and Other Properties Under
Department's Control

To ensure public safety on the state fairgrounds and other Department-controlled properties, the Mississippi Agricultural and Livestock Theft Bureau has the authority and necessary powers to provide law enforcement assistance, coordinate all events, maintain the public safety and peace, and request assistance from other law enforcement agencies, including but not limited to the Mississippi Department of Insurance State Fire Marshal's Office, the Office of Capitol Police, and any other state or local law enforcement agency as may be deemed appropriate by the Director.
