Short explanation of rule/amendment/repeal and reason(s) for proposing rule/amendment/repeal: This Administrative Code is being filed to: 1) remove coverage of EPSDT screenings by RHCs/FQHCs in a school setting, 2) remove Mississippi Youth Programs Around the Clock (MYPAC) coverage and reimbursement, 3) add language stating the wraparound facilitation is covered as a case management service and 4) set the fees for EPSDT services the same as those effective for State Fiscal Year (SFY) 2021 in compliance with Miss. Code § 43-13-117, as amended by MS Senate Bill 2799.

Specific legal authority authorizing the promulgation of rule: Miss. Code Ann. § 43-13-117.
