Short explanation of rule/amendment/repeal and reason(s) for proposing rule/amendment/repeal: Title 35.II.4.11 Retail Pickup from Distilleries and Native Wineries is a new regulation that clarifies the requirements for retail permittees picking up native wines and spirits sold by the Department of Revenue found in Miss. Code Ann Section 67-1-41(10).

Specific legal authority authorizing the promulgation of rule: Miss. Code Ann. Section 67-1-37(h), "To adopt and promulgate, repeal and amend, such rules, regulations, standards, requirements and orders, not inconsistent with this chapter or any law of this state or of the United States, as it deems necessary to control the manufacture, importation, transportation, distribution and sale of alcoholic liquor, whether intended for beverage or nonbeverage use in a manner not inconsistent with the provisions of this chapter or any other statute, including the native wine laws."
