Due to the delay of gasoline deliveries caused the cyberattack on the Colonial Pipelines computer network system, The Department issues this temporary rule to provide a waiver for ASTM Reid Vapor Pressure Specifications related to gasoline and gasoline blended with one or more percent ethanol. The reasoning for this waiver is to avoid supply disruptions for Mississippi and other states affected by the cyber attack through June 6, 2021 or until supplies are depleted. This should provide a greater supply of gasoline for sale in the state.

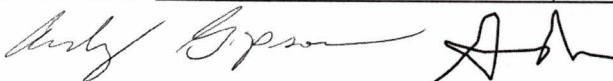
