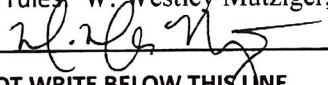

RESOLUTION

Whereas, it is necessary for the Occupational Licensing Review Commission to issue a resolution regarding the approval or denial of specific rules submitted for its review: NOW, THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED BY THE OCCUPATIONAL LICENSING REVIEW COMMISSION, that the following rules shall be known to have been approved by the Commission at a duly called meeting of its members on April 18, 2023, and may now be filed as final with the Secretary of State's Office for inclusion in the Mississippi Administrative Code:

- Rules of the Mississippi Board of Medical Licensure - Title 30, Part 2640, R. 1.14: Revision of the pain management medical practice rules; removing the issuance of a certificate for pain management practices.
- Rules of the Mississippi Board of Medical Licensure - Title 30, Part 2640, R. 1.6: Revision of the bariatric practice requirements; removing the issuance of certificates in favor of a digital process.
- Rules of the Mississippi Board of Pharmacy – Title 30, Part 3002, Chapter 4: Repeal of Chapter 4 in its entirety and add a new Chapter 4, R. 4.1, to implement a uniform policy. *Approved with the following amendment: correct highlighted typos.*
- Rules of the Mississippi Board of Dental Examiners – Title 30, Part 2301, R. 1.13(2)(H) & R. 1.37: Amendment to provide for conditional administration of local anesthesia by dental hygienists and assessment of associated certification fee.
- Rules of the Mississippi Board of Registered Foresters – Title 30, Part 1001: Cleanup and update to rules; implementation of the Military Family Freedom Act and Universal Recognition of Occupational License Act; increase of license renewal and late renewal fees under R. 5.4 and 5.5. *Approved with the following amendment: the public records request labor cost section under Chapter 2 be changed to reflect that the fee is to be charged based on the lowest paid salary or some variation thereof to reflect the language in Miss. Code Ann. Section 25-61-7.*
- Rules of the Mississippi Board of Registered Geologists – Title 30, Part 1101, Chapter 2, R. 2.7 & 2.8 and repeal of Chapter 4, R. 4.3(B): Deletion of table of contents; addition of R. 2.7 to comply with Miss. Code Ann. Section 73-50-2; addition of R. 2.8 to comply with Miss. Code Ann. Section 73-50-1; deletion of Geologists in Training Application fee, and deletion of proctoring.
