Short explanation of rule/amendment/repeal and reason(s) for proposing rule/amendment/repeal: The proposed changes to Part 2825 are to address administrative affidavits, clarify informal proceedings, add clarification to timelines of when dismissal can occur, and to add language that an appeal of a disciplinary action of the board panel does not stay the discipline ordered. This is to ensure that the board can carry out its duty of protecting the public.

RESOLUTION

Whereas, it is necessary for the Occupational Licensing Review Commission to issue a resolution regarding the approval or denial of specific rules submitted for its review: NOW, THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED BY THE OCCUPATIONAL LICENSING REVIEW COMMISSION, that the following rules shall be known to have been approved by the Commission at a duly-called meeting of its members on March 29, 2024, and may now be filed as final with the Secretary of State's Office for inclusion in the Mississippi Administrative Code:

- Mississippi State Auctioneer Commission - Title 30, Part 401, Chapter 1, Rule 1.16: Background Check Requirements. Addition of a new regulation regarding background check requirements.
- Mississippi Board of Nursing – Title 30, Part 2820, Chapter 1, Rule 1.3: Sanction and Fines. Revision of existing regulation to require licensees to update their address electronically and adds a requirement for a physical address.
- Mississippi Board of Nursing– Title 30, Part 2825, Chapter 1: Disciplinary Proceedings. Revision of Rules 1.2, 1.3, 1.4, 1.5, 1.6, 1.7, 1.8, 1.9, 1.10, 1.11, and 1.12. Revision of existing regulations to address administrative affidavits, clarify informal proceedings, add clarification to dismissal timelines, and to add language that an appeal of a disciplinary action of the Board of Nursing does not stay the discipline ordered.
- Mississippi Board of Nursing – Title 30, Part 2880, Chapter 1, Rule 1.1: Fees. Revision of existing regulation to add clarification to fees for adding collaborating physicians and clinical sites and to remove unnecessary fees.
- Mississippi Board of Nursing – Title 30, Part 2840, Chapter 1, Rules 1.1 and 1.5 for Advanced Practice and Chapter 2, Rules 1.1 through 1.10 for Cannabis Certification: Revision of existing regulations to define compatible practice and special privileges, add office screening for APRN's prescribing benzos and opioids, and to amend cannabis certification rules to align with new statutory requirements.
