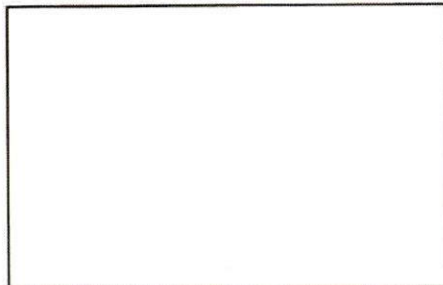

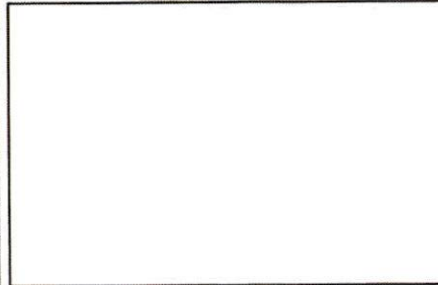

RESOLUTION

Whereas, it is necessary for the Occupational Licensing Review Commission to issue a resolution regarding the approval or denial of specific rules submitted for its review: NOW, THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED BY THE OCCUPATIONAL LICENSING REVIEW COMMISSION, that the following rules shall be known to have been approved by the Commission at a duly-called meeting of its members on June 10, 2024, and may now be filed as final with the Secretary of State's Office for inclusion in the Mississippi Administrative Code:

- Mississippi State Board of Public Accountancy - Title 30, Part 1, Forward and Chapter 1, Rule 1.1: Restrictions on use of Title Certified Public Accountant. Removal of repetitive language and revision of existing regulations to make consistent with statute.
- Mississippi State Board of Public Accountancy - Title 30, Part 1, Chapter 3, Rules 3.1.4, 3.1.5, and 3.1.11: Firm Permits. Removal of inaccurate and unnecessary language, shorten rule by reference to statute; and proposal for replacement of antiquated language.
- Mississippi State Board of Public Accountancy - Title 30, Part 1, Chapter 4, Rules 4.1.1, 4.1.2, 4.1.3, 4.1.4, 4.1.5, 4.2.1, and 4.3.6: Continuing Professional Education and Repeals Rules 4.1.8 and 4.2.5. Revised language to include required CPE hours the year following licensure. Removal of antiquated and duplicative language.
- Mississippi State Board of Public Accountancy - Title 30, Part 1, Chapter 5, Rules 5.2, 5.3.1, 5.3.3, 5.3.4, 5.3.7, 5.6, 5.7, and 5.8: Quality Review/Peer Review Rules. Revision to change "Quality Review" to "Compliance Assurance Program." Also removes antiquated language from the rules.
- Mississippi State Board of Public Accountancy - Title 30, Part 1, Chapter 8, Rules 8.2.1 and 8.2.3: State Board of Public Accountancy – Repeal of 8.1.1, 8.2.4, and 8.2.14. Repeals language that is found in Miss. Code Ann. § 73-33-3.
- Mississippi Board on Law Enforcement Officer Standards and Training – Title 31, Part 301, Chapter 1, Rule 1.1: Definitions and Chapter 2, Rule 2.2: Policy. Revision of existing regulation to amend the policy concerning military discharge in other than honorable conditions.
- Mississippi Board of Pharmacy– Title 30, Part 3001, Article XXX: Institutional/Long Term Care Facilities. Revision of an existing rule regarding requirement for dispensing medication in a long-term care facility. Revision of

language to replace the word “institutional” with “facility.”

- Mississippi Board of Pharmacy– Title 30, Part 3001, Article XXXV: Institutional Emergency Medication Kit Permits. Revision of an existing rule regarding regulations for the permitting of an institutional emergency medication kit for a long-term care facility and other institutional facilities.
- Mississippi Board of Pharmacy– Title 30, Part 3002: Various Administrative Rules. Rule 1.1 added language to Composition of Board – Repealed Rule 1.2, 1.3, 1.4, 1.5, 1.6, 1.7. Updated numbering to include administrative rules to the front and disciplinary matters towards the end. Also removed unnecessary language as needed. The changes presented to Chapter 8 were not approved.
