Short explanation of rule/amendment/repeal and reason(s) for proposing rule/amendment/repeal: The rule was amended to include information regarding Native Wineries added by HB 1284, SB 2555, and SB 2851 of the 2025 Regular Session. Other minor changes were made.

Specific legal authority authorizing the promulgation of rule: Miss. Code Ann. Section 67-1-37(h), the Department of Revenue has the authority "[t]o adopt and promulgate, repeal and amend, such rules, regulations, standards, requirements and orders . . . as it deems necessary to control the manufacture, importation, distribution, delivery and sale of alcoholic liquor . . . in a manner not inconsistent with the provisions of this article or any other statute, including the native wine, native spirit, and craft spirit laws."
