Short explanation of rule/amendment/repeal and reason(s) for proposing rule/amendment/repeal: A new rule was created to include information regarding craft distilleries and native distilleries added by HB 1284, SB 2555, and SB 2851 of the 2025 Regular Session.

Specific legal authority authorizing the promulgation of rule: Miss. Code Ann. Section 67-1-37(h), the Department of Revenue has the authority "[t]o adopt and promulgate, repeal and amend, such rules, regulations, standards, requirements and orders . . . as it deems necessary to control the manufacture, importation, distribution, delivery and sale of alcoholic liquor . . . in a manner not inconsistent with the provisions of this article or any other statute, including the native wine, native spirit, and craft spirit laws."
