Short explanation of rule/amendment/repeal and reason(s) for proposing rule/amendment/repeal: Individuals who conduct asbestos abatement activities in Mississippi and who are regulated by the Asbestos National Emission Standards for Hazardous Air Pollutants (NESHAP) regulations are required to be certified by MDEQ. The Asbestos Abatement Accreditation and Certification Act was amended during the 2025 Legislative Session to closely align with EPA's regulations and to make it easier to obtain certification. These proposed amendments reflect the recent changes to the Act and align this chapter with other MDEQ regulations.

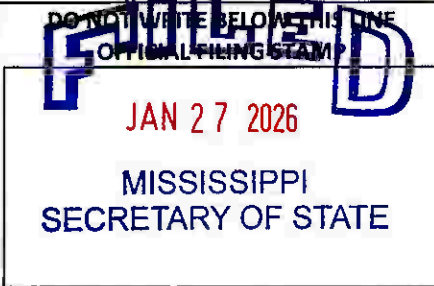
