Short explanation of rule/amendment/repeal and reason(s) for proposing rule/amendment/repeal: This is an amendment to revise Rule 5.1(H) to include failure to report alcohol abuse by a pharmacist, pharmacist intern, or pharmacist technician to the unprofessional conduct standard. This amendment also creates a new rule setting forth discovery procedures during disciplinary proceedings. It amends an existing rule to lessen the requirement on those to attend board hearings when entering into an agreed settlement order to only when required by the Board.
