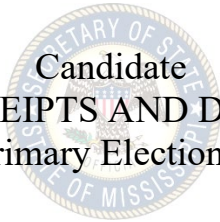

IMPORTANT

- (1) All candidates for office shall file reports in the year in which they are to be elected.
- (2) Pre-Election Reports are mandatory if the candidate is opposed, even if no expenditures were made during the period. In such case, the candidate shall submit a report indicating "0" (zero) for total amount of reported contributions and/or expenditures during this period.
- (3) Until a candidate files a Termination Report, annual reports must be filed in accordance with Miss. Code Ann. § 23-15-807 (b) (ii) and (iii).
- (4) The receiving office must be in actual receipt of the required reports by 5:00 p.m. on the deadline. If the deadline falls on a weekend or a holiday, the office must be in actual receipt of the required reports by 5:00 p.m. on the first working day *before* the deadline.

Authority: Miss. Code Ann. §23-15-801, *et. seq.*
