

Elections Division Campaign Finance Compliance Officer

Primary job responsibility is to oversee the filing of Campaign Finance reports filed with the Elections Division. Responsibilities include but are not limited to: receiving reports, coordinating with candidates and other election officials, and developing and designing Campaign Finance documents.

Responsibilities:

- Serve as lead contact for Campaign Finance with Election Division
- Work with Assistant Secretary of State and Senior Attorney to ensure compliance of Campaign Finance laws.
- Answer inquiries from the public and elections staff regarding reporting Campaign Finance contributions and disbursements
- Maintain archived records.
- Follow-up with fine and delinquent notices.
- Answer Elections Hotline calls; record questions for response.
- Develop yearly Campaign Finance guide for the public and candidates.
- Special projects as assigned by Assistant Secretary of State.
