ADVANCING MISSISSIPPI HEALTHCARE

Mississippi is at the very heart of medical research and advances. At any given time, there are hundreds of clinical trials taking place in the state, representing dozens of categories, from cancer and stroke research to diabetes and debilitating arthritis. This research aims to find new and effective therapies for illnesses that affect Mississippians at a higher rate than others across the nation.

Telemedicine is another healthcare advancement where Mississippi has excelled. Since 2003, when the University of Mississippi Medical Center first used technology to link trauma clinicians with rural emergency departments throughout the state, Mississippi has continued to be a national leader in telemedicine. And more recently, due to necessary restrictions from the COVID-19 pandemic, Mississippi has again made significant advancements in telemedicine, mainly through the expansion of rural broadband. The increase of this service has given underserved Mississippians access to advanced medical diagnoses and treatments they would not have had prior.

As expected, the COVID-19 pandemic has been the central focus of medical care in Mississippi. State Health Officer, Dr. Thomas Dobbs, says the collaborative efforts to take care of those in need throughout the pandemic has been remarkable and a true testament to the giving nature of Mississippians.

The Mississippi State Department of Health's (MSDH) mission is to promote and protect the health of the citizens of Mississippi. The MSDH strives for excellence in government, cultural competence in carrying out its mission, and local solutions to local problems. The Department identifies its values as applied scientific knowledge, teamwork and customer service. Mississippi's State Board of Health was established in 1877 to protect and advance health throughout Mississippi, and became the Mississippi State Department of Health in 1982. The major operations of the agency involve health protection, health promotion, and health planning, health equity, and the identification of communicable diseases and limiting its transmission.

The Department oversees disease surveillance by tracking diseases and creating outbreak management plans, while also coordinating statewide immunizations and vaccinations. MSDH also creates prevention programs and organizes laboratory testing for flu viruses, mosquito-borne diseases, STDs, and communicable diseases.

The Department's environmental protection consists of testing drinking water, regulating on-site wastewater and sewage-systems, and completing restaurant permits and inspections.

The Mississippi State Department of Health assists with disease and injury prevention by making tobacco control and cessation programs available, as well as creating nutritional training and information. The Department focuses on chronic disease prevention and management for arthritis, diabetes, asthma, heart disease, high blood pressure, cancer, and other diseases. It also regulates safety programs for biking, walking, car seats, and fires.

The MSDH helps keep the state safe by preparing the public for disasters and public health emergencies. It holds regular training sessions to ensure preparedness and create response plans. The Mississippi State Department of Health has emergency readiness programs and severe weather and disaster response programs.

The Department oversees the required and recommended childhood immunizations, as well as meningococcal and HPV vaccinations for adolescents. The MSDH also recommends vaccinations for international travel and creates seasonal flu vaccinations for all ages.

The Mississippi State Department of Health is responsible for licensing and regulating child care facilities, nursing homes, assisted living facilities, hospitals, trauma care, and other healthcare facilities. The Department also provides educational information and counseling, physical exams and contraceptive supplies, STD/HIV testing, and pregnancy care. The Women, Infants and Children (WIC) program creates supplemental food packages through its Electronic Benefit Transfer card (EBT), nutrition education classes, breastfeeding support, and health care referrals.

Along with issuing birth and marriage certificates, the Department supervises and monitors medical treatments in the state. It also coordinates patients with community resources and give special care for children with chronic or disabling conditions.

In addition to all of this, the Mississippi State Department of Health provides the public and media with information. The Office distributes emergency notifications to the public as well as provides the latest information on all MSDH program areas. This includes public outreach campaigns using a variety of media from TV, radio, social media, billboards, etc. The Office ensures real-time updates via its website, Facebook, Twitter, and other digital media sites and applications (apps).

Dr. Dobbs is a board certified Infectious Diseases and Internal Medicine physician with extensive training in public health and epidemiology. Dr. Dobbs recently joined MSDH as the Deputy State Health Officer after two years working in Laurel, MS, as a practicing physician, and as Vice President for Quality, and Chief Medical Officer of South Central Regional Medical Center. Prior to this, he served four years as a District Health Officer in southern Mississippi, and then four years as the State Epidemiologist with MSDH. Dr. Dobbs is a graduate of Emory University and received his medical degree and his master’s degree in Public Health at the University of Alabama at Birmingham. He has been active in public health research and advocacy, working globally through the Gorgas Tuberculosis Initiative in Russia and Cambodia, and in the U.S. through appointments at UMMC and the University of Florida (as regional clinical consultant with the Southeastern Regional TB Center). He has an appointment at the John D. Bower School of Population Health at UMMC, teaching Epidemiology and Health Policy.

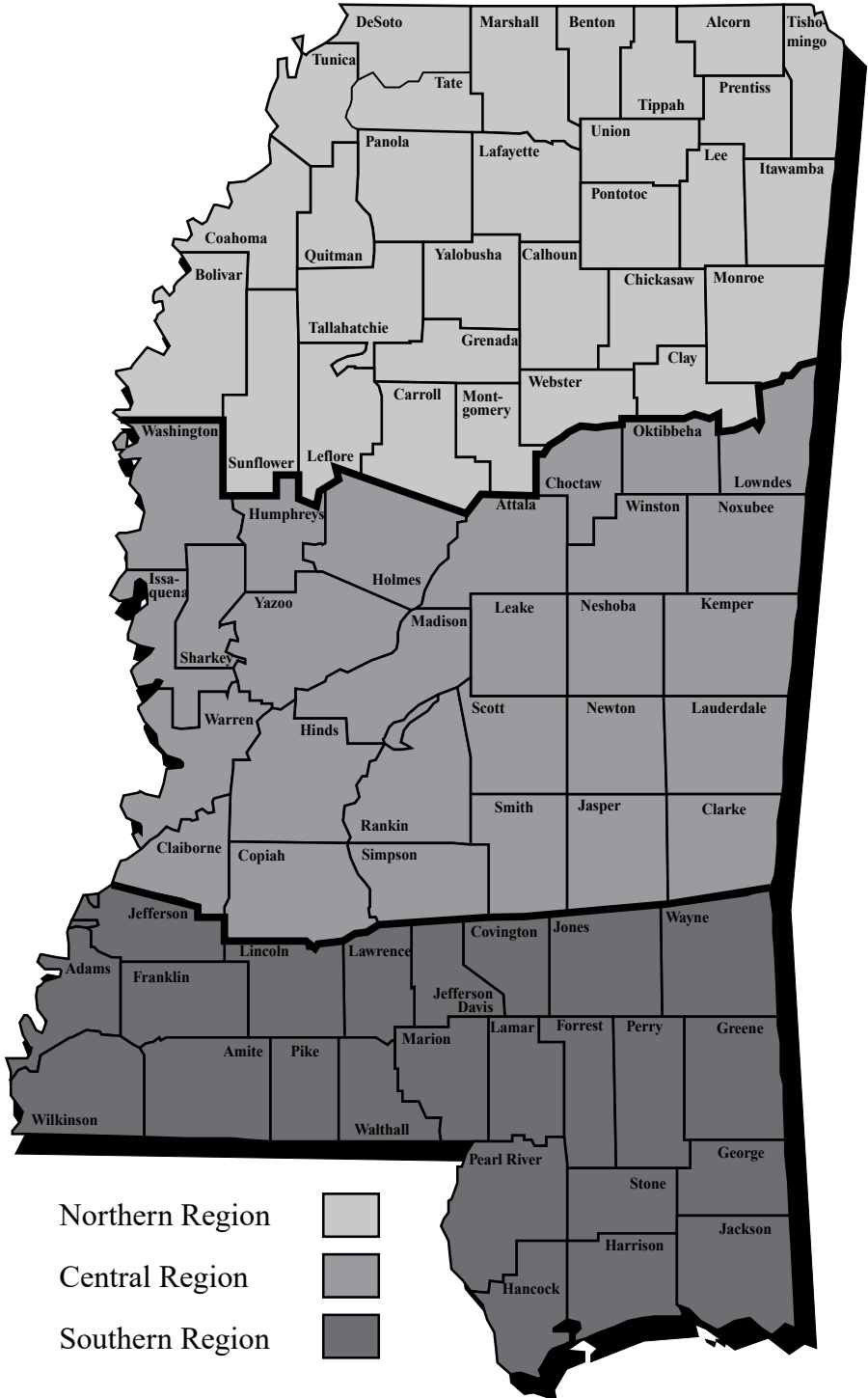

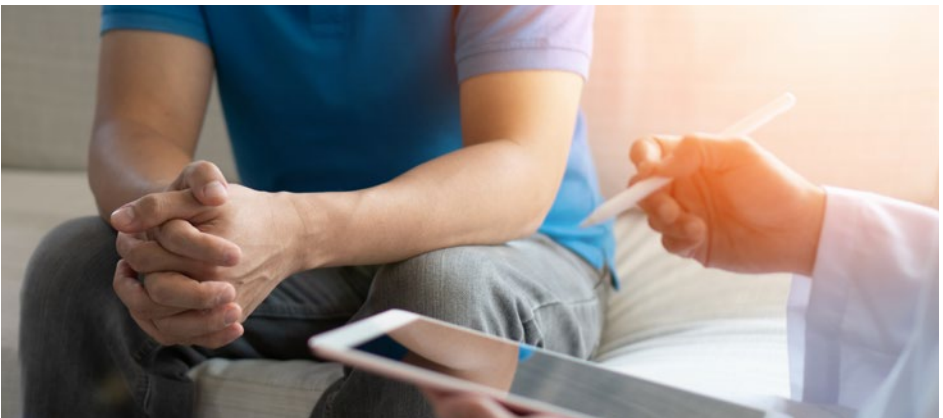
The Mississippi Department of Mental Health (DMH) provides and financially supports a network of services for people with mental illness, intellectual/developmental disabilities, substance abuse problems, and Alzheimer's disease and/or other dementia. Their goal is to improve the lives of Mississippians by supporting a better tomorrow, today.

The mental health service delivery system is comprised of three major components: state-operated programs and community service programs, regional community mental health centers, and other nonprofit/profit service agencies/organizations.

The Mississippi Department of Mental Health continues to work towards a recovery-oriented system of care which focuses on a network of support and services. This includes state-run behavioral health programs, community-based care, peer-run services, involvement from family, and other types of support that incorporate the values and principles associated with recovery. DMH administers and operates six behavioral health programs. The programs provide inpatient services for people (adults and children) with serious mental illnesses and substance abuse.

Regional community mental health centers (CMHCs) operate under the authority of regional commissions appointed by county boards of supervisors comprising their service areas. The 14 regional health centers provide a range of community-based mental health, substance use, and in some regions, intellectual/developmental disabilities services. CMHC governing authorities are considered regional and not state-level entities, and the Department of Mental Health is responsible for certifying, monitoring, and assisting CMHCs. Community mental health centers are the primary service providers for community-based mental health and substance abuse services.

There are five program locations that provide residential services for people with intellectual/developmental disabilities and one center for adolescents with intellectual/developmental disabilities. These programs are a primary vehicle for delivering community services throughout the state.
