IMPORTANT

- (1) Pre-Election Reports are mandatory if the committee has received any contributions or made any expenditures in support of, or in opposition to, a 2021 county candidate and/or ballot measures appearing on the November 2, 2021 county election or November 23, 2021 runoff ballots.
 (2) Annual Reports are mandatory unless a Termination Report is filed prior to December 31, 2021.
 (3) Until a committee files a Termination Report, annual and pre-election reports must be filed in accordance with Miss. Code Ann. § 23-15-807 (b) (ii) and (iii).
 (4) The receiving office must be in actual receipt of the required reports by 5:00 p.m. on the deadline. If the deadline falls on a weekend or a holiday, the office must be in actual receipt of the required reports by 5:00 p.m. on the first working day before the deadline.
