EXECUTIVE ORDER 1360

WHEREAS, on July 21, 2015, President Barack Obama issued a Proclamation ordering the flag of the United States to be flown at half-staff upon all public buildings and grounds and certain federal facilities until sunset, July 25, 2015, “as a mark of respect for the victims of the senseless acts of violence perpetrated on July 16, 2015, in Chattanooga, Tennessee”:

WHEREAS, previously I issued Executive Order 1359 lowering the flags of the United States and the State of Mississippi until sunset on July 22, 2015, in respect for the servicemen killed in the attack:

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Phil Bryant, by the authority vested in me as Governor by the Constitution and laws of the State of Mississippi, do hereby order all flags of the United States of America and the State of Mississippi be flown at half-staff on all buildings and grounds of the State of Mississippi and all areas under its jurisdiction until sunset on Saturday, July 25, 2015, in conformity with the President’s Proclamation described herein.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Mississippi to be affixed.
