EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 1365

WHEREAS, on October 1, 2015, at least nine people were killed and others injured in a shooting rampage on the campus of Umpqua Community College in Roseburg, Oregon; and

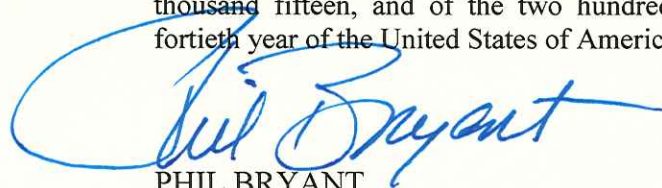
WHEREAS, the prayers of the people of this State are with the victims and their families:

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Phil Bryant, by the authority vested in me as Governor by the Constitution and laws of the State of Mississippi, do hereby order all flags of the United States of America and the State of Mississippi be flown at half-staff on all buildings and grounds of the State of Mississippi and all areas under its jurisdiction beginning at noon on Friday, October 2, 2015, until sunset on Monday, October 5, 2015, in respect for these innocent victims of violence committed in Roseburg, Oregon.
