Executive Order 1367

WHEREAS, pursuant to Miss. Code Ann. Section 33-13-175, the authority to convene a General Courts-Martial in the Mississippi National Guard is limited to the Governor, the Adjutant General and any other general officer under such regulations as the Governor may promulgate.

NOW THEREFORE, I, Phil Bryant, by the authority vested in me as Governor by the Constitution and laws of the State of Mississippi, do hereby order that the Assistant Adjutant General of the Army National Guard and the Assistant Adjutant General of the Air National Guard have the authority to convene General Courts-Martial.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Mississippi to be affixed.
