EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 1368

WHEREAS, on November 15, 2015, the President of the United States of America issued a Proclamation ordering the flag of the United States to be flown at half-staff on all public buildings and grounds until sunset on Thursday, November 19, 2015, as a mark of respect for the victims of violence perpetrated on November 13, 2015, in Paris, France; and

WHEREAS, the prayers of the people of this State are with the victims and their families:

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Phil Bryant, by the authority vested in me as Governor by the Constitution and laws of the State of Mississippi, do hereby order all flags of the United States of America and the State of Mississippi be flown at half-staff on all buildings and grounds of the State of Mississippi and all areas under its jurisdiction beginning immediately, until sunset on Thursday, November 19, 2015, in respect for these innocent victims of violence committed in Paris, France.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Mississippi to be affixed.
