## **EXECUTIVE ORDER 1433**

**WHEREAS**, Mr. Grubbs was killed in a vehicle accident while responding to a structural fire on Saturday, November 3, 2018; and

WHEREAS, the prayers of this State, particularly those of the Magee community, are with his wife, children, and his many family members and friends:

**NOW, THEREFORE**, I, Phil Bryant, by the authority vested in me as Governor by the Constitution and laws of the State of Mississippi, do hereby order the State Flag be flown at half-staff on all public buildings and grounds in the City of Magee, Mississippi, from sunrise until sunset on Wednesday, November 7, 2018, in memory of firefighter Dustin Grubbs.
