EXECUTIVE ORDER 1447

WHEREAS, on July 17, 2019, President Donald J. Trump issued a Proclamation ordering the flag of the United States to be flown at half-staff upon all public buildings and grounds on the day of interment until sunset, "as a mark of respect for the memory and longstanding service of John Paul Stevens, retired Associate Justice of the Supreme Court of the United States."

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Phil Bryant, by the authority vested in me as Governor by the Constitution and laws of the State of Mississippi, do hereby order all flags of the United States of America and the State of Mississippi be flown at half-staff on all buildings and grounds of the State of Mississippi and all areas under its jurisdiction from sunrise until sunset on the day of interment, Tuesday, July 23, 2019, as a mark of respect for the memory and longstanding service of John Paul Stevens, retired Associate Justice of the Supreme Court of the United States.
