EXECUTIVE ORDER 1555

WHEREAS, Mississippi mourns the death of Jackson County Supervisor Melton Harris, Jr., who passed away on July 13, 2021; and

WHEREAS, Harris was a leader and true public servant in the community. He was first elected to the Jackson County Board of Supervisors in 2008, and served as a representative for District 2, which covers parts of southeast Jackson County, serving as board president in 2010, 2015, and 2020; and

WHEREAS, Harris was born and raised in Grenada and graduated from Carrie Dotson High School in 1965, and then went on to Tougaloo College, where he earned a degree in mathematics and physics; and

WHEREAS, Harris served his nation in the armed forces and was honorably discharged as a military policeman from service in the U.S. Army during the Vietnam War era; and

WHEREAS, Harris was employed by Chevron Refinery, retiring in 1999; and

WHEREAS, in their time of loss, the prayers of this State are with his wife, Portia Harris; daughters, Donise and Melani; son, Marcus; and his many other family members and friends:

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Tate Reeves, by the authority vested in me as Governor by the Constitution and laws of the State of Mississippi, do hereby order the State Flag be flown at half-staff on all public buildings and grounds in Jackson County, Mississippi, from sunrise until sunset on Friday, July 23, 2021, in memory of Supervisor Melton Harris, Jr.
