EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 1313

WHEREAS, on December 18, 2012, the President of the United States issued a Proclamation ordering the flag of the United States to be flown at half-staff on all public buildings and grounds until sunset on the day of interment in respect for the memory of Senator Daniel K. Inouye, President Pro Tempore of the United States Senate, who died on Monday, December 17, 2012; and

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Phil Bryant, by the authority vested in me as Governor by the Constitution and laws of the State of Mississippi, do hereby order all flags of the United States of America and the State of Mississippi be flown at half-staff on all buildings and grounds of the State of Mississippi and all areas under its jurisdiction until sunset on the day of the interment of Senator Daniel K. Inouye.


IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Mississippi to be affixed.
