
Votes cast in the County of Bollivar, Mississippi





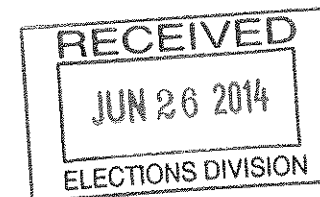
