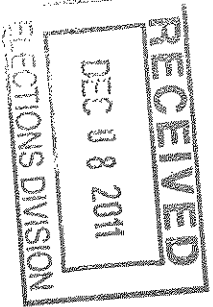


BEFORE the Court is the matter of the Clay County Election Commissioners consisting of Linda Ivy, District 1, Tommy Bryan, District 2, Glenda Nadeau, District 3, Wendy Fuller, District 4, and Jessie Ivy, District 5 requesting that the Court enter an order to correct the errors of totals in the contest of Initiative 31 and 26, November 8, 2011 General Election.

On Initiative 31, Eminent Domain, there was a discrepancy of 45 "yes" votes which changes the 125 vote total to a 170 vote total in the Pine Bluff Precinct. There should be 69 "no" votes added to the 32 vote total making this total 101.


On Initiative 26, Definition of 'person', there was a discrepancy in the East West Point Precinct. The 499 "yes" votes should be changed to 488 "yes" votes.



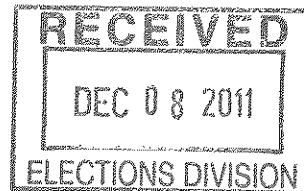

ORDER TO CORRECT THE OFFICIAL RECAPITULATION  
RESULTS OF NOVEMBER 8, 2011 GENERAL ELECTION

THIS DAY this matter came on for hearing on Petition of the Clay County Election Commissioners, consisting of Linda Ivy (Dist. 1 ), Tommy Bryan, (Dist. 2 ), Glenda Nadeau (Dist. 3 ), Wendy Fuller (Dist. 4 ), and Jessie Ivy (Dist. 5 ) for an Order to correct the error of totals in the contest of Initiative 31 in the Official Recapitulation certified to the Secretary of State for the State of Mississippi on the 8<sup>th</sup> day of December, 2011, and based on the matters proffered, the Court finds as follows the Circuit Court of Clay County is a court of competent jurisdiction and has jurisdiction over this matter:


The Court further finds that in Initiative 31, Eminent Domain, there was a discrepancy of 45 "yes" votes which changes the 125 votes to 170 in the Pine Bluff Precinct. There was also a discrepancy of 69 "no" votes which changes the total of 32 to a total of 101 in the Pine Bluff Precinct.

On Initiative 26, Definition of 'person', there was a discrepancy in the East West Point Precinct. The 499 "yes" votes should have read 488."yes".

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED AND ADJUDGED, that Honorable Delbert Hosemann, Secretary of State for the State of Mississippi be and is hereby directed to correct the certified results of the Official Recapitulation Results for Clay County, Mississippi in the contest of Initiatives 31 and 26.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED AND ADJUDGED, that the Circuit Clerk of Clay County mail a certified copy of this order to Honorable Delbert Hosemann , Secretary of State for the State of Mississippi.
