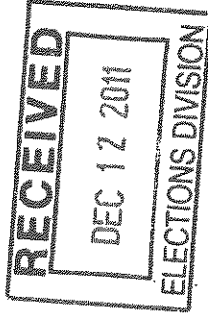

WE DO HEREBY STATE ON OATH that:

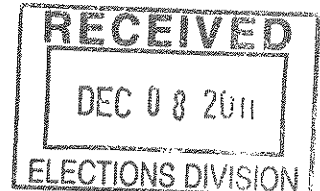
1. The General Election Management System (GEMS) did not transfer complete results to the Statewide Election Management System (SEMS) on the precincts.

3. The initiatives were: #26 "Definition of a person", #27 "Voter ID", and #31 "Eminent Domain".
4. The results read: #26 - YES 1,032 - NO 1,804,
#27 - YES 1,546 - NO 1,459,
#31 - YES 1,660 - NO 1,341

I declare under penalty of perjury that the foregoing is true and correct and that this petition was signed on this the 2 day of Dec, 2011.

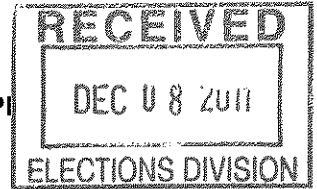

ORDER

This day this matter having come before the circuit court of the 6th Judicial District on the Motion to Open and Recertify November 8, 2011 General Election Results, said Motion having been filed by the Election Commission Chair of Wilkinson County, Mississippi on the 08 day of December, 2011.

Pursuant to the Motion it is averred, under oath by the Election Commission Chair of the Wilkinson County, Mississippi, that:

1. The General Election Management System (GEMS) did not transfer complete results to the Statewide Election Management System (SEMS) on counts involving split precincts;
2. There were 9 precincts in Wilkinson County, Mississippi, in the November 2011 general elections;
3. The total votes casts cast in the precincts had to be manually entered; however, the results for the 3 initiatives were contained and held on a separate tab within the program, and were overlooked due to human error;
4. The Circuit Clerk of Wilkinson County, Mississippi, certified election results to the Mississippi Secretary of State on November 18, 2011, however, the final numbers on the 3 initiatives as certified were incorrect and, instead, should have been as follows:

Initiative No. 26 – Definition of a Person – Yes – 1032
No – 1804

Initiative No. 27 – Voter ID Yes - 1546
No - 1459

Initiative No. 31- Eminent Domain Yes - 1660
No - 1341

IT IS; THEREFORE, ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that the Election Commission Wilkinson County, Mississippi, be and it hereby authorized to reopen the November 8, 2011 General Election, and amend the results solely and specifically as described above in paragraph numbered 4 supra, to reflect the total votes cast by the citizens of Wilkinson County, Mississippi, on Initiative Nos. 26, 27, and 31.

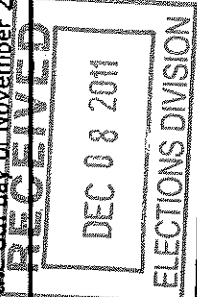
