NOTICE OF INTENT TO SELL PUBLIC LANDS

It is the intent of the Secretary of State, Public Lands Division, Jackson, Mississippi; to sell by sealed bid, pursuant to Section 29-1-37(2) of the Miss. Code of 1972 Annotated (as amended), the following tax-forfeited properties situated in the **Hinds County, Mississippi**:

The sale will be conducted pursuant to applicable statutes and administrative rules of the Secretary of State. Said parcels were acquired by the State of Mississippi by forfeiture for non-payment of ad valorem taxes. Tax title to the above listed parcels is believed to be good. The State of Mississippi will convey such title as is vested in it.

Individuals or corporations may submit bids. By law, nonresident aliens or associations composed in whole or in part of nonresident aliens may not bid. Bids must be submitted in the following form:

Each bid should be on a separate 8.5 x 11 inch sheet of paper. Place your completed bid in an envelope. Seal it, and write "**Hinds County—Do not open until September 18, 2015**" in the lower left hand corner of the sealed envelope. Deliver your sealed bid to "Secretary of State, Public Lands Division—Bid", by U.S. Mail to Post Office Box 136, Jackson, MS 39205 or by hand or courier to 125 S. Congress Street, Jackson, MS 39201.

Sealed bids must be received in the office of the Secretary of State by 5:00 p.m., September 17, 2015.

Bids will be opened and read aloud on September 18, 2015 at 10:00 a.m. in the Public Lands Division at 125 S. Congress Street, Jackson, MS. The Secretary of State reserves the right to reject any and all bids.

Successful bidders will be notified, and payment of the bid amount must be made within fifteen (15) days of notification. All sales are subject to the approval of the Governor. Parcels are sold on an "as is" basis. All sales are final, and no refunds will be made. No more than one-hundred sixty (160) acres may be purchased by one person within one year.
