**ATTENTION:** The information below reflects the active voter count reported in the Statewide Election Management System (SEMS) maintained by county election officials. The citizen voting age population ("CVAP") estimates have been revised to reflect the 2023 American Community Survey 5-year estimates. However, due to concerns about accuracy for jurisdictions with a total population of less than 10,000, those jurisdictions CVAP are still the CVAP from the 2020 Census and are designated with an "\*".
